The PowerPoint must focus on an event (ie Fall of Constantinople), person or group of people (ie Klephts and Armatoloi), organisations (such as Filiki Eteria), period of time (such as the Years of Turkish Occupation) or place (such as Messolonghi).

4.	Credit has been given to the sources where the information or images were found.	
5.	Presentation is original, clear, easy to understand and follow.	
6.	Slides are related and organised and show a sense of continuity.	
7.	Has at least 10 slides. Every slide has text and corresponding image. The whole PowerPoint has between 200 and 300 words.	
8.	There is at least one slide explaining the significance of the chosen topic of the PowerPoint to the Greek people and their history.	
9.	Writing shows capable use of correct spelling, grammar and rich vocabulary.	
10.	Presentation has visual impact, correctly using maps, timelines, paintings from the era etc.
