The Ascension of the Lord and Pentecost

Last week we celebrated the ‘Ανάληψη του Κυρίου’ (The Ascension of the Lord). On this day Jesus ascended or rose to heaven after his forty days on Earth following his resurrection. Before he departed, though, He had made a promise. "The Holy Spirit will come to you. He will give you power to tell people about me."



On Sunday the 4th of June we celebrated the event known as the Pentecost which marks the fifty days after Jesus’s resurrection. Ten days after Jesus’s ascension, the disciples had gathered in a house to pray. Suddenly, a noise like a strong wind filled the house in which they were assembled. Flames of fire were said to have floated above the disciples’ heads. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they began to speak different languages.



A crowd gathered outside wondering what was going on. Peter, one of the disciples, made a long speech, preaching to the crowds outside about Jesus. That day, about 3,000 people became followers of Jesus and were baptised. This day is also regarded as the Church’s birthday!

The Australian Hellenic Memorial Foundation in cooperation with the Greek Consul for Educational Affairs is pleased to announce the commencement of the 2017 Australian Student Competition and invites all students from Years 1 to 12 to participate.

The aim of the competition is to explore the Australian and Greek involvement in Greece during both World Wars. Entries must focus on one of the four themes presented in the Australian Student Competition Booklet:

The entries will be accepted according to student school year level, with each year level having two alternate presentation methods. Whilst it is not specified in the booklet, the AHMF will also accept Power Point submissions for year levels (7-9) and (10-12).

The prizes will be awarded to student entries according to the following school year levels:

Year Level	First	Second	Third
1 – 3	\$100	\$75	\$50

10 – 12	\$250	\$150	\$100

Apart from these financial prizes for the winners, **all** student entries will receive a Certificate of Participation and badge commemorating the bonds between Australia and Greece.
